



Important Eyeliner Information

Remember- everyone heals differently. All permanent makeup results vary from person to person.

After your procedure, slight redness, bruising, and some irritation of the eye area is expected. Depending on your sensitivity level, swelling may persist 1-3 days. This can be reduced by applying a clean, covered bag of ice over the treatment area in 10 minute intervals.

Keep the area clean, free from dirt, oil, cosmetic eye creams, and makeup.

Do not use any exfoliants or acid-based products.

Wash your hands with an antibacterial soap before touching the area.

Applying an excess of post care balm may cause infection. Do not apply any additional healing agents to the treated area as they may strip the pigment. If scabbing or peeling occur, **DO NOT** pick or peel it.

DO NOT apply makeup directly on top of the treated area for 5 days. If you do wear makeup AROUND the area, remove it gently with water and a mild cleanser. Avoid makeup removing cloths and harsh cleansers.

Eyeliner Post-Treatment Instructions

Day of Treatment... Wipe the area once an hour with the wips given to you. Use them hourly until they are gone. After they are gone, apply post care balm (After Inked- supplied to you)

2-5 days after treatment... Wash the area with CLEAN HANDS twice a day. Gently pat dry with a clean paper towel and apply a thin layer of post care balm (After Inked supplied to you)

Reapply balm 2-3 times throughout the day, maintaining a thin and moist barrier protecting the skin.
